It is our prayer that this past Easter has been one of the most meaningful Easter's you have experienced. At Berea we were blessed by a powerful cantata, Amazing Grace; our children inspired us with Bible verses and songs they have learned; and we were able to experience the Passion and Resurrection of Christ through our Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Easter Sunrise and Easter Morning services. But you do know him, because he remains with you and will be in you (John 14:15-17 CSV).
